COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROCESS

- 1. Project Proposal
 - a. Proposal application completed and submitted to HRCA staff, Board notified
 - b. Staff and BPAAC (if necessary) determine whether proposal is allowed according to pertinent land use documents.
- 2. Board Review and Action
 - a. At a Board of Directors meeting, the Board takes action
 - i. Deny, move forward, ask for more information
- 3. Delegate Presentation and Action
 - a. Proposal is presented to the Delegates by the proposing party
 - i. Deny, move forward to public process
- 4. Community Notification and Public Process Begins
 - a. Minimum 10 day notice to the public of upcoming public meeting for input
 - i. Notice via e-blast, web-site, posters at rec centers, etc.
- 5. Delegate Action
- 6. Board Action
