Recreation Centers

Recreation ID Card.....303-791-2500

You must be a homeowner (or renter with consent) in Highlands Ranch. Recreation cards may be purchased at any of the four recreation centers, Monday - Friday, 6:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m., Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.; \$8.00/card. All members nine years of age and older are required to show their ID cards upon entering HRCA recreation centers. Children under the age of nine must be supervised at all times within HRCA recreation centers by a responsible adult.

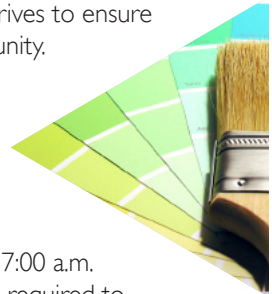

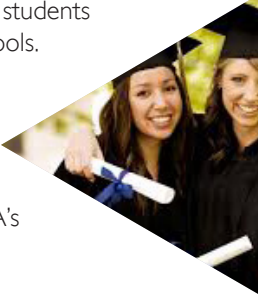
