* **The HRCA Waiver, Release, Covenant Not To Sue and Indemnity Agreement must be signed and fully completed every calendar year by an adult, or a legal guardian for children 17 and under before being certified by the HRCA to climb at its facility.**

* **A climbing orientation must be completed with an HRCA Climbing Wall Staff before being allowed to climb.**

* **Recreation cards must be checked in at the equipment desk prior to climbing or bouldering to show current punches of HRCA certifications.**

* **Must be 7 years old to climb or boulder. Individuals 12 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at all times while in climbing area.**

Open is dedicated for open climbing. The climbing wall is staffed and staff is available to belay.

Advanced Climbing is for climbers that are 13 years of age and older, belay certified, and able to climb at least a 5.9 route or higher.

Bouldering/Belay Certified is for Bouldering or Belay Certified individuals. The wall is not staffed during these hours. Bouldering is the art of traversing left and right without being roped in while staying below the designated HRCA height limits. If an individual is HRCA Belay Certified they can belay other individuals, novice belayer's can only belay during staffed hours.

Orientation is the basic climbing class and will cover HRCA policies, rules and procedures as well as a few basic techniques like the use of the harness, carabiners, belay commands, and wall safety. The orientation class takes about 30 minutes. Please arrive early to complete a waiver and check out equipment. As a courtesy to participants already in class, participants who arrive late may be referred to the next class, which could be the next business day.

Belay Class is for individuals 13 years and older. It is an in-depth class on the art of belaying. The class involves knot tying, belay commands, the act of belaying, spotting, and wall safety.
